There were twelve bitches entered in the class, with ten being presented on the day. Seven were graded Very Promising and three were graded Promising.

Thank you to the breeders and exhibitors for entering your "young ladies" under me. This was a lovely class to judge. The first three bitches particularly were of very high quality. I will watch how these bitches progress through their show careers with great interest. It is very good to see three dogs entered in the Open class with progeny in this class.

The winning bitch is from the Excellent Merit dog, Ch Iccara Hard as Nails CDX ADX. She won on the day because of her excellent type, firmness and ground coverage.

The next three bitches are from Eisenland Fernando, the first two being litter sisters. These bitches had very good strength, very good pigmentation and very good length of upper arm. Their general firmness of ligamentation could be better on the day. The bitch in 4th place, the placement of the croup could be better.

The bitches in 5th and 6th positions are from Seigen Jaafaru and again are litter sisters. These two bitches were of very good type with high withers, presenting a very good picture in stance, at the moment are very loose in the hindquarters.

Good luck in the future to the owners and breeders of all the bitches presented and I am sure they will make the transition into the older classes. You can only judge what you see on the day and as they mature these places may change, but this class is the basis for a very good Junior Bitch Class next year.

In the Puppy Dog class we have an excellent class exhibited here where I was able to award the Very Promising grading four times. I believe these gradings would be received with ease at any show in this country.

In 1st place, **Iccara Venus Villain** sired by the Swedish import, Ravdansens Orvar. The dam very pleasingly is my Siegerin, Iccara Vegas Showoff. He is an above medium size puppy who stands with an excellent topline, a beautifully coloured and pigmented dog. At this stage he also shows a very good sequence of steps with balance and harmony.

In 2nd place, **Iccara Undercover Agent**, again sired by the Swedish import Ravdansens Orvar, this time ex Iccara Double Diamond my V1 bitch. This is a large, strong, beautifully pigmented, masculine grey dog who again exhibits a very good topline with very good angulations and very harmonious movement.

In 3rd place we have **Jentol Xclusive Line**, sired by the German import Arcos vom Friesenblick, the son of the Sieger Yasko vom Farbenspiel. This dog brings to us very good lines. He shows very good expression. At this time of his development he needs overall firmness.

In 4th place we have a dog **Alderhaus Call Me Tramp**, sired by Seigen Jaafaru, who is brother of course to Seigen Jorja, my Excellent Merit 4 bitch. Jaafaru was also the Intermediate Sieger at the Main Breed Show and brings to us very good breeding. This dog is very well proportioned, lovely type. He stands with very good topline, is very well angulated both fore and hind. At this moment he is also a little loose but with more firmness can certainly contest the higher positions.

### Summary of Class

On the day, 8 of the 11 entered, were exhibited in this class. The overall quality was high with the grading of Very Promising being awarded seven (7) times and the grading of Promising once. Sires to have the most influence in the results were Ravdansens Orvar, Pino vom Drei Birkenzwinger and Saarbachtal Pure Zarbo. The winning bitch "Nostalgia" was a clear winner.

Size, strength and proportions of most exhibits was very good, as were fore and hindquarter angulations. Heads, eye colour and expression were good to very good. Croups, together with firmness of hocks and elbows, and movement were attributes that generally could have been better.

As with any other Minor class, the older exhibits have a greater advantage than the younger ones, due to the significant physical development that occurs between six and nine months of age. Some of these Minor Puppy Bitches could have been shown to greater advantage, had they been given just a little more meaningful training.

It would be my expectation that "Nostalgia", "Viola" and "Vixen" should be top 10 to 20 material at a National level for their age group. "Nostalgia" has the credentials to be amongst the best.

On the day, 4 of the 5 entered, were exhibited in this class. The overall quality was good with the grading of Very Promising being awarded three (3) times and the grading of Promising once. Size, strength and proportions of the top exhibits were very good, as were fore and hindquarter angulations. Also heads, eye colour and expression were good to very good. This was a small class where the last two Puppy Bitches could have been shown to greater advantage, had they been given just a little more meaningful training and conditioning.

I would think that "Kiwi Kisses" could be of top 10 potential at a National level for her age group.

Aged between 12 ½ and 17 months, my Junior Bitches presented a very pleasing overall picture. In the class of 7 bitches, I was pleased to be able to award the grading of **Very Good Merit** to two exhibits, with four gaining an easy VG and one left ungraded and withdrawn. (Overshot)

**Size:** It was good to see that the size range from 55 to 59.5 cm was easy to establish, with no surprises or pressure.

**Strength:** Very good strength and substance ranging from strong and substantial to medium strong bitches of good substance.

**Coat, Colour and Pigment:** Overall very good, 2 Sables, the others Black and Gold. Good texture and condition of coats, nothing too harsh or stressed.

**Proportions:** Very good ration of length to height, and chest proportions found in all the bitches presented, 2 decidedly stretched, others a little more compact.

**Type:** With my two leading bitches a cut above the rest, type ranged from Excellent through to Good.

**Head and Expression:** Beautiful heads not only in the merit bitches, with lovely breadth of skull and foreface, only a couple of finer heads.

**Eyes** from the beautiful warm dark eye that we strive for to a good medium eye.

**Ears:** No ear problems, generally well set and carried.

**Withers:** 3 bitches presented with high withers, the others had good wither.

**Backs** firm in all cases

**Croups:** Generally good, with some slightly short and slightly steep.

**Forequarters:** Well angled in my winning bitch, and leaving a little to be desired, in that, similar to the croups, a slight improvement in length in one and in the placement in most, would be advantageous.

**Hindquarters:** Very good hindquarter angulation in all.

**Chest Proportions** and development were good, one slightly short underchest.

**Fronts** were correct in all, and **Sequence of steps** correct.

**Hocks and Elbows** were not a problem, with only one bitch leaving a little to be desired in that respect and the other animals showing good elbow connection

**Movement:** Very good in my two Merit Bitches, and one other, who made the most of her attributes and gave it all she's got, with the other four bitches all showing slight restrictions because of the slight imbalance between the good fore and very good hindquarter angulation and the lay of the croup.

**Dentition:** With the exception of the un-graded bitch with the overshot mouth, all are in possession of strong, faultless dentition with a good scissors bite.

**Temperament:** No temperament problems in any of the six graded bitches, with one showing a little initial lack of self confidence, but she came good after a few minutes in the ring and deserved her place on the pegs. The bitch that was withdrawn will benefit from a little extra socialisation.

## OPEN BITCH CLASS

### JUDGE: BARRY O'ROURKE

In the judging of the Open Bitch class this year, on viewing the catalogue I see that the bitches presented are, I believe, of the highest quality we have seen at this stage of our development.

Only one of the ten bitches presented has been exhibited in this class before, however in this class we have the Reserve Siegerin from last year, the West Coast Challenge Grand Victrix, the National Puppy winner, last year's Junior Bitch and then National Intermediate Bitch Siegerin.

In 1st position and this year's Siegerin we have the bitch **Iccara Vegas Showoff**. This is the first time this bitch has been presented to us. A bitch who meets the standard perfectly, she exhibits harmonious lines, she is beautifully coloured, has an absolutely feminine expression and at all speeds shows the overall firmness and dryness we desire. This bitch today has won this class with ease with her anatomical and character attributes.

In 2nd place we have the bitch **Eisenland Dejavu**. This is a large, substantial and absolutely excellent brood type. Sired by the Sieger Denargun Brownd Off, I believe this bitch has enormous potential for the breed in our state.

In 3rd place, **Eisenland Impulse**, a daughter of the German import Uno von der Urbecke, who of course is also the sire of our Sieger. This is a bitch who stands on the maximum height, a bitch who impresses with her far-reaching gait, also a bitch of excellent brood type. We look for her progeny with great interest.

In 4th place **Seigen Jorja**, sired by the Sieger Troy von der Noriswand. This bitch was my Intermediate Siegerin at the Main Breed Show. This bitch comes from a litter which I have followed with great interest; she is one of five in a litter who have all received the 'A' and 'Z' with excellent passes. As I have said, Jorja comes from a very strong family line with proven results. Again, because of her strength we look forward to her progeny with great interest.

The first four bitches in this class were all sired by previous National Siegers, as is the 6th place getter who is a daughter of the German Sieger, Ursus von Batu.

In 5th position we have the previous Reserve Siegerin, **Hinterhaus Tempest**, the dam of course of Seigen Jorja. This bitch has produced well for our state. She is large, strong and harmoniously constructed, beautifully coloured and pigmented. Again an excellent brood type.

In 6th place and Excellent Merit, **Bruvic Bobbys Bienchen**, sired as mentioned by the German sieger Ursus von Batu ex our state siegerin German import Bluebell von Arminius. This is a lovely, medium size, medium strong, correctly proportioned bitch, again an excellent brood type. I would prefer the pigmentation a little stronger, however this is an easy correction with the choice of sire.

## OPEN DOG JUDGE: ROBYN KNUCKEY

Firstly, I would like to thank the Association for the opportunity to judge the Open Dog class at such a prestigious event. Thank you to the exhibitors and breeders for presenting such a wonderful class to judge. This was one of the most exciting Open Dog classes in a number of years because of the high number of high quality young dogs presented in the Open Class at this event for the first time. I would like to thank

Jodie Davis for typing the critiques, Kay Sauer for marking the sheets during the critiquing process, Andi Crace for acting as Ring Steward and Margaret Ronald for her efforts to co-ordinate the critiques following the show.

There were twelve dogs entered, with eleven presented on the day. The grading of Excellent Merit was awarded five times, five Excellents and one Very Good. A note of great worth in this class is that five dogs had some sort of title in obedience or agility, with another dog (Ch Aldahoven High Flyer) gaining his CD title in the month following this event. Therefore over half the class has a working title and only one of these was a German import. Five dogs entered in the Open Class presented progeny over the weekend.

The Open Dog class would have been a more complete picture of the stud dogs available in WA if Ravdansens Orvar had also been presented. It is important to note that this dog sired five class winners and presented a high quality progeny group, from limited stud opportunities. If presented, he would have competed at the top of the class because of his progeny, even considering he is six years of age. His progeny group presented very good pigmentation, size, excellent eye colour, top and underline, very good heads and very good croups. Consideration needs to be given to the fronts, but as most of the progeny are young at this point, this may improve. He is a representative of Fedor Arminius and Yago Wildsteiger Land lines. Comments on the individual dogs are included in the critique section of the report.

Nine of the eleven dogs were bred in WA, with one of these being imported in dam. One dog was bred in SA and one a German import. This is exciting for Western Australia and a compliment to the breeders of WA, with four of the five Excellent Merits being "home grown". What further cements their quality is the first four Excellent Merit dogs were taken to National and all were placed in the first twenty and two of these were on the pegs. Well done to the owners and breeders of these dogs.

The virtues of the Open Dog Class are

- Very good to excellent type
- Very good to high withers
- Generally very good length of upper arm
- Lay of the croup
- Firmness of hock joints
- Eye colour is medium to dark
- 8 dogs in the class have normal elbows
- 5 dogs presented with a working title and 1 gained a working title since the SBE.

Points for consideration with the Open Dog Class are:

- Size: 7 dogs in the class were large to very large
- Length of the croup
- Firmness of the elbows
- Strength

Common line breeding of the Open Dog Class:

- Q litter Arminius 4 dogs
- Uran Wildsteiger Land 3 dogs
- E/V litters Kirschtal 3 dogs
- Fedor Arminius 3 dogs

Only one dog in the class was line bred on dogs bred in Australia. There were four dogs presented in the class with no line breeding.

Three dogs presented were out of Thunderbolt daughters, one out of a Thunderbolt granddaughter, one out of a great granddaughter and one out of a mother line bred on Thunderbolt. Three of the five Excellent Merit dogs are from these lines, including the Sieger and Reserve Sieger.

Two dogs presented are sons and one is out of a Kazan daughter. These dogs were all graded Excellent.
