SBE 2005 Summary of Class.

On the day, all 5 that had been entered, were exhibited in this class. The overall quality was high with the grading of Very Promising being awarded five (5) times. Sires to have an influence in the results were *Bruvic Bobbys Basko, *Quosh vom Drei Birkenzwinger and *Aust. Ch. Aldahoven High Flyer. Sirelines of these baby puppies lead to connections with Jeck vom Noricum, Lasso Neuen Berg and Ulk vom Arlett, which is somewhat representative of the major bloodlines in Germany today. The winning baby dog "Utopian Dream" was a clear winner, due to his superior construction and lovely topline.

Size, strength and proportions of most exhibits was very good, as were fore and hindquarter angulations. Heads, eye colour and expression were overall very good. Croups, together with firmness of hocks and elbows, and movement were attributes that were generally very good.

As with any other Baby class, the older exhibits normally have a greater advantage than the younger ones, due to the significant rate of physical development that occurs between three and six months of age. At times some of these Baby Puppy Dogs could have been shown to greater advantage, but this is "part and parcel" of exhibiting in this age category.

It would be my expectation that "Utopian Dream" and "U Rock" should be top 10 material at a National level for their age group. "Utopian Dream" has the potential to be amongst the best, but it is "early days" and all of these young males have a long development process to take place over the next 18 to 24 months. The two "Quosh" baby puppies, "Lasko" and "Luck", are also showing much potential for such a young age.

Thank you to the breeders for presenting a class of high quality, with all bitches being graded Very Promising. There were 6 puppy bitches entered with 5 presented on the day. Of the 5 bitches presented, 4 are Troy v Noriswand daughters. All were from 2 surveyed parents, bred in WA and exhibited by the breeder. These young bitches are still going through their growing stages, being between 10 $\frac{3}{4}$ and 11 $\frac{3}{4}$ months. Therefore are still to attain their final firmness of joints and topline.

Very pleasing to see was all bitches, at this stage, were medium to above medium size. Good strength was noted in all bitches. Eye colour was correct in 3 bitches and medium in the other 2. Areas for improvement are in the angulation of the forequarter and the length and lay of croup. These problems are present worldwide.

The bitch in first place, Seigen Cherry Pie (Troy), was the clear winner of the class, on the day. She has very good angulations and proportions for her age, with powerful movement at all speeds and very good top and underline. The length and lay of croup was the best in the class. Congratulations to Dennis and Christine Gallacher for breeding and owning this lovely bitch and good luck in the future with her.

The 11 bitches represented 7 Sires and 10 dams.

The catalogue showed only three bitches with their A and Z stamp, but it is always a bit of a juggling feat, to get in their X rays and have their coat and muscular condition at their peak for a State Breed Exhibition. The window of 6 months, does not give us much room to play with.

I am looking forward to seeing the rest of the class gain these all important letters to their name in due course, and I wish their breeders and owners all the very best for the future of these lovely young bitches.

My findings overall were as follows:

Size: Not one animal on maximum size. Of the bitches presented, 4 are large, 6 above medium, and 1 of medium size.

Type: Excellent to very good type critiqued as 36 and 45% respectively, with the one bitch of good type, still showing potential for further development.

Strength ranged from strong to medium strong in a 50-50 ratio with 6 of my bitches of medium strength, all well proportioned, with none being critiqued as decidedly stretched.

Sexual Characteristics: All the bitches, from the large, strong ones to the medium strength animals were absolutely feminine in appearance and expression, with my two VG Merit bitches presenting a picture of type and proportion, top and underline, that epitomises the clean, flowing lines of a harmoniously constructed German Shepherd Bitch.

The eye colour too, was very pleasing, no light eyes! We had three with dark, and 8 with good medium eye.

Withers were seen to be high in 9 of the bitches, 81% of the class, with two definitely level, and we saw straight, **firm backs in all**.

Croups were good in the Junior Bitch class, with nothing exceedingly steep or detractingly short, although there is always room for improvement with seven, that is 63% being critiqued as being slightly short, and four slightly short and slightly steep.

The forequarters were overall very good in 8, with 3 bitches possessing good forequarters. The upper arm was decidedly short in one, although the other ten bitches had a better length of upper arm, six of the exhibits should have been better angled. 54%...

The hindquarter angulation could not be faulted in the bitches presented.

The fore and underchest development was very good in this class too, with nothing too pronounced, affecting the balance or detracting from the harmonious picture of a well structured young bitch built to cover the ground effortlessly with great endurance as her structure gives her plenty of heart and lung room.

All the bitches stand correct in front, and 90% stepped correct going, one showed **hocks** still to firm, with all stepping correct coming. Of this class we saw overall very good reach and drive with just one showing a definite restriction in her reach. Not one showed objectionable looseness of **elbows**.

It has been a pleasure to judge this class, and a pleasure to be able to award the grading of **Very Good Merit to two** of the lovely bitches, with the next **eight being graded Very Good** and **one bitch Good**. She still has time and room for development, and I would expect her to attain the VG without difficulty with just a little more maturity and muscular development.

The sire lines as well as the dams, have been given as part of my critiques, so hereunder just a very quick rundown of the Excellent Select or SBE Merit males that feature in the breeding.

INIFF VAGRANT was represented by 7 bitches through his son, the WA SBE Sieger Lindendale Thunderbolt. IWAN LECHTAL by 6, in 2 of these through his Ex Select sons Leishjaclyn Raindancer and Denargun Brownd Off. TROY von der NORISWAND sired 3 of the bitches and his son Seigen Jafaaru EX M one. EISENLAND FERNANDO – Uno Urbecke sired three of the bitches. PRIMA ZORBA Is carried by two of the bitches presented. TRIUMPHS KAZAN is carried by two of the bitches

We have seen some lovely progeny from him and Ying Yang, line bred on his dam, the WA Siegerin Iccara Hellcat, should go a long way towards keeping him firmly entrenched in our pedigrees, as one of the top Lindendale Thunderbolt sons, (Iniff Vagrant) carrying also Quincito Awol, Prima Zorba and not to forget Karlstadt Tumblin Dice CD, another Ex Select dog featuring strongly, also through the pedigree of the dam

The Dam, Iccara Qrystal, brings a dash of long limbed, strong boned influence of Arko vom Huhnegrab, going back to Quando Arminius, and on the female line taking us back to one of the most successful combinations based on Karlstadt Tumbli Dice CD. (Masuta Piaute)

Thanks to Margaret Ronald for her wonderful service, again, for doing the critiques on the day and getting them to the judges in such a timely manner. Thank you to all the ring and gate stewards.

There were 5 bitches entered and exhibited in the Intermediate Bitch class, from 4 different sires. Pino v Drei Birkenzwinger had 2 daughters exhibited, 2nd and 5th. All were bred in WA, from 2 surveyed parents and presented by the breeder. The 2 bitches, 1st and 3rd, from Iccara Kennels, had both been successfully breed surveyed. The other 3 had not been presented for breed survey prior to the show. All had passed with an AZ stamp. Two bitches have no linebreeding. The other three are linebred on (Lindendale Thunderbolt 3-2), (Yago Wildsteiger Land 5-5 and "O" litter Batu 5-5), and (Yago Wildsteiger Land 4-5). The first bitch was graded Very Good Merit and other four were graded Very Good.

The benefits of the class are overall strength, angulations, type and proportions. Size was large to very large, between 59.5 and 61cm. Overall the eye colour could have been darker, although, there were no light eyes. Croups were of good lay in general but could be longer. One animal in the class has a high set tail.

The winner of the class, *Iccara Nostalgia AZ (Orvar), was the stand out animal in the class. This bitch has already had an illustrious show career, winning in Qld, Victoria, SA, as well as in WA. Even though she was presented out of coat on the day, her quality shone through, in stance and in movement, with correct top and underline, very good angulations and croup. She was also a part of the winning Breeders Group for Iccara Kennels. Congratulations to Larry and Sue Woollard, I will watch her continued career and I'm sure she will make the transition into an outstanding Open Bitch, over the next 12 months. Good luck with "Nossie" for the future, in the ring and her breeding program.

The intermediate dog class is always very exciting, and although again, we only had a very small class, the animals presented are typey, masculine representatives of the breed that will shortly make their debut in the Open Dog Class.

The two males presented, one sable one black and tan, are of above medium size, strong, and of very good to excellent type, of very good proportions of length to height.

Both young dogs have beautiful, expressive, definitely masculine heads, with the eye colour dark in my winner, medium in the other, both with good strong muzzles, broad skulls and definitely male at first glance.

Their withers are high, their backs are firm, and both dogs have good croups, just slightly short, and slightly steep. They both have very good fore and hindquarter angulation, and show very good fore and underchest development, a little pronounced in the second placed dog, whose elbows are still to firm.

The winning dog was exhibited in very firm condition, and his convincing ground covering movement did not appear to be affected by a slight cut in his right rear pad. He stepped correct coming and going, with the second dog in this class not quite as correct in front, standing just a little east west. Both dogs exhibited free flowing, far reaching movement with powerful drive.

Accordingly the dogs were graded Very Good Merit for the 1st exhibit who has gained the A and Z stamps, and a convincing and deserved Very Good for the 2nd placed dog, who I believe also has his A and Z although the catalogue did not reflect this.

Both of these typey and expressive dogs should have no problem at all making the transition to the Open Dog Class. It has been a pleasure to judge this small class of nevertheless convincing high quality, and I wish the dogs, their breeders and owners, all the best for their future and show career.

OPEN BITCH

JUDGE: JOHN FENNER

SBE 2005 Summary of Class.

In the Open Bitch Class for the SBE 2005, we received twelve (12) entries, of which eleven (11) were shown on the day. Three (3) bitches from last year's SBE Open Bitch Class returned this year, as did two (2) Intermediates and two (2) Juniors from last year. The other four (4) bitches have been exhibited in previous SBE's in one class or another.

The total entry for dogs and bitches appears to have plateaued in recent years. Last year, ten (10) bitches were exhibited on the day. At last year's SBE there were 8 Minor Puppy Bitches, 4 Puppy Bitches, 6 Junior Bitches and 3 Intermediate Bitches exhibited. Of those 21, only 6 remained to be competitively shown at this year's SBE.

As the Open Bitch judge, the theme of my adjudication was to reward deserving breed worth and focus the breeders of this State on the basics of their breeding over the next twelve months. I envisaged this to create a continuing foundation to build a stronger and more predictable future for the breed in this State. This entails pointing out to all breeders what principles have worked to the breed's advantage at this event and this should consequently reflect on all breeders' efforts in the ensuing years.

In order to successfully contribute to the breed as a breeder, one must be able to produce high quality male dogs as well as high quality bitches. We have seen this in Germany with kennels such as Arminius, Wienerau, Wildsteiger Land, Bad Boll, Agrigento, Batu and Kirschtal. In Western Australia, we see only just a little of this, but the common factor, the sireline of Quanto von der Wienerau is starting to come into play. Not that the sirelines from Canto and Mutz will not produce top offspring, but not to the same extent. The bonus is that top females of the absolutely correct type, strength and sexual characteristics will be also produced, whilst the potential to retain the line will be enhanced significantly.

This is not to say that the motherline is not important. It is equally so, but the advantage is to have the prepotent sireline within the brood bitch to compound use of the Quanto bloodline. Examples of this occur with the line breeding usage of Lasso di Val Sole, the X litter Arminius, the Q litter Arminius, Uran Wildsteiger Land, Palme Wildsteiger Land, etc.

The physical "show" condition of exhibits placed 8th, 9th and 10th precluded them from consideration to be elevated into the top group, as the picture of infirmness and spasmodic movement presented during the gaiting, was not of the required standard. A number of bitches were "in season" or hormonal and this affected their performance on the day. Those bitches finally placed in 6th, 8th, 9th and 10th were obviously not at their very best, which I have been able to observe on many occasions in the past. All of these bitches have the potential to positively influence the breed, so it was disappointing that they did not present their attitude and attributes at their normal high level.

My final judgement on each exhibit in the Open Class has to be a combination of the following factors :

- Probability of future breed contribution.
- Actual breed contribution to this point of time,
- Anatomical virtues.
- Character and temperamental attributes,
- Performance in the past.
- Presentation on the day.

Clearly, some exhibitors and observers are not cognisant of what aspects should be taken into account in an Open Class at a Main Breed Exhibition or State Breed Exhibition. Not only does the judge consider what is presented on the day, but most importantly, all factors of the previously existing phenotype and genetic make-up of each exhibit. This includes physical condition, mental attributes and reactions observed under previous occasions, and potential to make a significant contribution to the future of the breed.

All of the bitches in this class have previously been Breed Surveyed successfully and shown at Specialty Shows with distinction to Surveyors and Judges. In this context, when considering all the aspects of the exhibits shown in this class, wherever there arose a matter of interpreting the material placed before me, all benefit of doubt was given in favour of the bitch, if in question. Slight or mild imperfections of character, temperament and gun sureness resulted in the loss of one grading per each factor, taking into account all of the above reasons. Therefore, my final gradings become self evident.

OVERVIEW : Ladies and Gentlemen, The State Breed Assessment has, by its own definition, created an event where breeders and owners alike can evaluate their kennels more decisively than they had previously been able to do. The breeder can use this show to orientate himself and to exhibit his own breeding plan to aid him in his future selections. It is therefore essential that we as judges maintain the same belief and concept in this event without deviation until we can make it clearly visible that the type of animal is interwoven throughout the classes. With the effect of the State Breed Evaluation we began to have a small but strong group of males complementary to each other and more importantly cementing our type. By sharing each other's stud dogs we are able to pool their genetic worth and promote further development and growth.

In 2003 I had the enjoyment of judging the Junior Dog class. At this stage the breed event was 14 years old. In my own opinion assessing that class we had created an elite group of young males upon whom we could stand tall in Australia and have these cemented animals' bloodlines to breed on. They represented the continuation of the years of breeding, the infusion and additional lines being added, while we still maintained our main motherlines and tail male lines. Three of those dogs presented at the 2003 State Breed Evaluation were in the first six in their class at the National. Last year we had the pleasure of seeing four of our Open Dogs again placed in the first 20 Open Dogs at the National. One of those exhibited was also to be the Intermediate Dog Sieger at the Main Breed Show.

The establishment of the Excellent Merit award continues and fosters the elite group. The criteria for the Excellent group therefore becomes dogs who are in the front of the class in this state in the awarding of excellent. They should have benefits in regard to the major faults exhibited. Most importantly, they must be breed survey class 1 and possess the 'A' and 'Z' stamp; they must show they have a positive genetic and pheno influence to make by their progeny being exhibited, and possess anatomical features and breeding that convinces me they can make a positive contribution to the breed in our state. These dogs must show strong masculinity and strength of bone. Selection of the Merit dogs must also be from proven bloodlines that are compatible with each other and should be complementary. In my own assessment of the class today, although small in number, is at the same time one which has the proven merits and benefits in our 17th year.

In the choice of the Sieger - which I found difficult not so much in anatomical or breed worth but in the fact my eventual Sieger had been Sieger on the two previous years - I felt that in promoting this dog again I may not be realising our full benefits. However, it is also a dog show. It is also an event that shows the progeny of those dogs and therefore the dog in number one position and my Sieger for 2005 is **Champion Eisenland Fernando**.

Fernando has proven again today he is anatomically the best dog in this state. He is, in my opinion, our best grey dog since Prima Zorba and before him Dumondaith Junker. He also has presented to us progeny of the highest calibre. His son also became his main challenger, which of course proves this dog's inherent producing capabilities. I congratulate him and the owners on this dog's third Sieger award. He has also of

course proven the same on a national basis where he was National Puppy Dog winner and Reserve Challenge winner from the Intermediate class at the 2003 National under the renowned Eric Orschler of the Von Batu prefix.

As stated, In 2nd place we have the son, **Iccara Xman**. A dog who stands at 65cm and who at 2.1/2 years has already achieved correct musculature. This dog fortunately is black and gold. Also he has an excellent hip score of 1-1 and an elbow classification of 0-0. But we cannot deny the father who has also produced the son. This dog for me shows many of the breed benefits we require in this state to perpetuate the influence of the sire and his sire, Ch Eisenland Fernando's bloodlines in Western Australia. In this case also his dam, Baxpan Ofellia is a daughter of my junior sieger and previous Main Breed Show sieger Hasenway Wild Knight who is the son of the sieger Ch Dorsten Monte Cito, and for the benefit of Western Australia the WA state sieger of 1990 Hasenway Putz, who is out of a daughter of the sieger and gold medallist Quincito Awol. This dog has an impeccable pedigree, is bred to produce and continue the many benefits of both the sire and motherlines.

In 3rd place Excellent Merit we have the dog **Aldahoven High Flyer**. This dog was one of my elite juniors in 2003 and was placed Excellent 9 at the 2004 National and Excellent Merit at the 2004 State Breed show. This dog has also presented to us progeny on the week-end which include the Baby Bitch and Minor Dog winner. He is sired by Nitro von Tronje whose grand sire was sieger Lasso vd Neuen Berg and on the dam side was the sieger Ulk von Arlett. His dam, Aldahoven Magenta, is daughter of the Dutch dog Quarlos von Niewlandshof. This dog certainly impresses us with his overall firmness and dryness and especially proved his working dog worth in the off-lead exercises and the grading of excellent in the open dog trial.

In 4th place Excellent Merit is my junior sieger of 2003 **Iccara Enemy Within**. This dog was in that elite class and since then has continued the promise I showed in him where he was the challenge winner at our 2004 championship show under Louis Donald, placed in show under Fay Stokes, reserve cc at the West Coast Challenge 2004. He has achieved the winning of our Triple Crown and becomes the second dog in its history to also win the open agility so he received two excellents in obedience and the excellent merit award in the breed. This dog needs to come back to us with progeny for further elevation.

In 5th place Excellent Merit is **Saarbachtal Pure Zambo**, sired by the late Adashad The Fugitive who was sired by the sieger Prima Zorba. He is ex Tobareny Whistlin Dixie, a daughter of our state sieger Skefmore Maurie out of the siegerin Tobareny Leillani. This dog presented to us the first time as an Open, being placed 3rd in the junior dog class earlier, 9th Excellent at the National. He comes from very well known lineage being Prima Zorba 2,4-3, Prima T litter 3,5-4,5 so further inbreeding on Prima Zorba should be avoided. In saying that, this dog has all the masculinity and strength of that line. His head is without fault in the planes of the foreface, the depth of eye colour, the ear set and both upper and lower jaws. A dog who exudes his masculinity. He should be considered for animals requiring strength and substance of both head and body. I am pleased to see this line and this dog presented to us.

In 6th place Excellent 1 is **Alderhaus Quintessential**, and so the cut-off must occur somewhere. This dog is also from my Merit group of 2003 and was placed highly in the National of the same year. Anatomically while standing he is a very beautiful dog. He presents the sire lines of the Austrian and Australian sieger Iwan v Lechtal. His dam, Eisenland Zaska, is litter sister to national gold medallist and West Coast Challenge gold medal winner and Excellent Select Eisenland Zilli, who of course was sired by our own previous dual state sieger Triumphs Kazan. This time coming from the gold medal and excellent select Lasko v Wildsteiger Land out of the producing bitch Eisenland Implicit. This dog certainly has the pedigree and the anatomical virtues to produce on. I would have liked to have promoted him into the Merit group however he did not give us the performance we would require for that elevation. Again I would like to see this dog come back with progeny.

In 7th place Excellent 2 is **Cherylton Johnny Walker**. Again a dog sired by the dual sieger Triumphs Kazan ex Cherylton Felicity, also an Excellent Merit bitch. A dog that I have assessed both in Western Australia and in the eastern states in open company. A dog who holds his grading successfully but does not quite give the performance required for the Merit group.

In 8th place Excellent 3 is **Dorian vom Louwers Hoeve**. This dog is sired by the current German sieger Larus von Batu ex Carine vom Winnloh. This is a very good anatomically constructed dog who should be overall a little firmer and I would prefer to see the character a little bit more outgoing. Care needs to be taken in regard to this and seeing this dog can present himself for the future.

Orpheus von der Krauterwiese. This is a dog who unfortunately was withdrawn but at the same time we thank the owners for presenting him to us only seven days out of quarantine. This is a dog I selected for Australia for his many breed benefits. He is a dog described by Eric Oschler at the 2003 sieger show as having the perfect forequarter. This, coupled with his lineage - his sire line Vantor von Batu is the son of the

sieger Ursus von Batu, and a daughter out of the Kazan breeding, Quartz Del Templari. His dam Isa von der Krauterwiese is a daughter of our Austrian and Australian Sieger Iwan vom Lechtal. So in the promotion of this dog and in fact the importation I was guided by two major points: (a) his anatomical worth especially in relation to his forequarter, and (b) the inheritance of the Sieger Ursus von Batu and the close in-breeding to what has probably been our best producing German male in 20 years, Iwan v Lechtal, and so we look to this dog's influence in our state.

The last dog, also withdrawn, was the dog **Sabaranburg Centre Stage**. Again this dog sired by Triumphs Kazan ex Iccara Heartbeat of whom he is typical. Unfortunately this dog was withdrawn.
